Special Call Meeting, Tuesday, July 13, 1954.

The Board, at a special call meeting, met at 7:30 PM, in the Director's Room of the Deposit Bank, with all members excepting Mrs. Stone, being present, and the following business transacted:

Present was Mr. W. P. Anderson, Magistrate, who requested that Board of Trustees draw up a resolution opposing the removal of Trains 7 & 8 as proposed by representative of L & N Railroad who had appeared before Fiscal Court. The Board requested that Mr. Anderson get Attorney Marshall Funk to draw up the resolution in legal form for their signatures.


Mr. Anderson reported that he had found that it would take approximately 45 tons of rock and 720 gallons of oil to lay a coat of blacktop  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches deep and 16 feet wide. Material to cost approximately \$164.45. Total cost with labor added would be around \$200.00 for 300 feet. Under this plan Mr. Anderson would do the work using his equipment and equipment borrowed from the State Highway Department. He reported it would be several days until oil came in to do the job. Streets should be swept with sweeper before any blacktop is put on.

Present also was Mr. J. R. Flora and Mr. E. W. Carter who made the proposal that City assess all property owners according to footage on their property and build all unpaved streets. It was proposed that City stand 25% of the cost and property owners 75%. The Board agreed that this was the only fair way to do it and the projected idea was taken into consideration.

Occupation Licenses - Clerk reported on difficulties of collecting same.

There being no further business at this time the Board adjourned.
