The regular business meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove, Ky. was called to order by acting chairman Charles Whitley. Members present were Chas. Whitley, Maurice Marr, Dr. James Hill and Gary Vincent. Visitors were James Gilley, Judge Blue and Jerry Marr. A motion was made by Maurice Marr and seconded by Gary Vincent to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Dr. Hill and seconded by Maurice Marr that a bill for \$85.64 from McLellan Stone Co., for paving streets be paid. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Dr. Hill and seconded by Maurice Marr that \$50.00 car expenses be paid to city patrolman. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Chas. Whitley and seconded by Dr. Hill that a bid to furnish and install a water line behind Mrs. <sup>Grace</sup> ~~Leva~~ Martin be accepted, as follows. per ft. 2.25, taps 100.00, gate valve 125.00, 90degree turns 50.00, end line plug 15.00, fire plug, 275.00. 6 x 2 thread tee 45.00, This limited to 1500.00 excluding meter fee. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Dr. Hill and seconded by Maurice Marr that Charles Whitley serve as chairman of the board through Sept. 1972 with each board member to serve as mayor three months at a time. The motion carried.

The city Judge reported 167.00 collected as fines and fees and a replevin bond of 131.50. One fine of 40.50 was probated for a period of six months.

A motion was made by Maurice Marr and seconded by Gary Vincent to adjourn. The motion carried.
