2. Mr. Keener was present as he has received his appointment as police judge but he has not been sowern in. He is to be added to the payyoll effective August 1. Mr. Keener asked Trustee McGuffey to check on his bond. Mr. Keener asked if someone wanted to appear before Magistrate Morehead instead of him, would this be permissable. Trustee McGuffey volunteered to contact Henry Potter regarding this.

3. Marshall Denton was not present.

4. The Cemetery account is \$2036.88. Mr. Hardy has paid \$160 on his account leaving a balance of \$150.

5. A site has been chosen for the new tool shed at the cemetery. Roy Beckham is to begin work as soon as possible.

6. The city account now stands at 4747.34 and the fire truck account a5 1544.15

7. There were no representatives from the Industrial Development Board.

8. Street Markers were not discussed.

9. The Zoning committee had no report.

10. It was decided that since the rural fire truck is used in the city to great advantage, the rural fund will not be assessed \$100 for housing the truck.

11. The information on the hearing for the increase in water rates still has not been located.

12. Mayor Jordan reported he has been unable to get the repair work done on Second Street but McLellan has promised to do this. Magistrate Morehead has done a good job in patching some holes.

13. The street be the cemtery has been gravelled.

14. There was no further report on the vapor light near the Hardy Funeral Home.

15. Trustee Madison reported she was unable to get any information on collecting delinquent taxes.

16. A discussion was held on the water pressure situation. The pressure is turned down at night in order to protect the water lines. No decision was reached on how to handle this situation. 17. ^Clerk was asked to write Oscar Belcher, Ray Hendrick and David Perkins regarding weeds on their lots.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
