Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, June 3, 1969.

The Board met at The American National Bank and Trust Company with one member, Trustee Joe Lowe, absent. Visitor was ^Jack Walker.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

2. Chairman Melton read a letter from the Highway Commission setting forth that the innerchange at Smiths Grove is not plausible. It seems this will not be forthcoming.

3. Agreement has been reached to furnish water to the N/S rest area. We are to pay the difference between the four and six inch line and they will maintain the line and we would be allowed the taps.

4. Accounts have discovered the bank charged \$500 too much for the water construction interest. This is being investigated.

5. Water system has had a little difficulty. Tower pump burned out. It has been recommended that this be replaced with a 7HP instead of the 5HP.

6. Trustee Blackwell reported all is well with the fire department.

7. Judge Blue had no report.

8. Trustee Hill stated the best time for Jim Cullen to take his vacation would be June 15 for one week. Wash Finn is to substitute for \$10 per night. He reported he had investigated Bonnieville and Park City regarding the amount paid their patrolman and came up with the following.

Bonnieville - \$300 salary, \$200 car allowance and car insurance. Park City - \$325 salary, car, insurance and gas furnished by the city.

He will check a couple of more towns similar to these.

9. Trustee Hill reported the Railroad Commissioner was apalled at the condition of the upper crossing and promises repairs. He was also of the opinion that the gates should be installed at the Main Street Crossing. The State which pays approximately 90% of the cost of the gates says they are not necessary. This subject is still alive.

10. There being no further business, the Board adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
