Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Tuesday, March 1, 1966.

The Board met in regular session at the American National Bank and Trust Company with all members present.

1. Chairman Melton opened the meeting and apologized to Judge Blue for his lack of information concerning payment of fine fees to judges. He had been unable to contact Judge Griffin. Clerk was asked to write the County Judge for clarification.
2. Clerk was asked to write the Attorney General as to the legality of a zoning committee for a sixth class city.
3. Trustee L. Carl Rasdall reported that Benton Davis had asked to use the fire station for the voting place for the tobacco referendum to be held on March 10. This was agreeable with all members.
4. Trustee Gene Blackwell presented a bill for \$12 for 12 pairs of gloves for the fire department. Trustee Powell made a motion that this bill be paid by the City. Trustee Rasdall seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
5. Trustee Rasdall reported satisfactory progress on the purchase of the water system. He announced that preconstruction contracts are to be opened in his office on March 8 at 10 AM. All interested persons are invited to attend.
6. Clerk was asked to write William Natcher a letter and also Fred Spired and Rex Logan thanking them for their help in the purchase of the water system.
7. Clerk reported the drain on Main Street had been cleaned. L & N has responded that they will check their drain. David N. Perkins has given verbal promise to clean up his service station lot.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
