

CALLED MEETING ABOUT FUTURE OF WATER PLANT: - March 11, 1979

A special meeting was called on Sunday, March 11, 1979 at 5:00 P.M. at the County Fire Station. Those present were Leland Anderson, Robert Appling, Paul Proffitt, Carolyn Harlin, & Charles Cowles.

The situation with the water works was discussed. After much discussion Robert Appling moved, Leland Anderson seconded that the City of Smiths Grove negotiate with Warren County Water District for the sale of the City's Water System. The vote was unanimous. A referendum will be held. The details of that will be worked out with the City Attorney.

Mr. Paul Proffitt moved; Mr. Leland Anderson seconded that the City hire Mr. Jerry Parker to represent the City along with Mrs. Harlin to negotiate with Warren County Water District over the interceptor sewer lines. Motion carried.

Mrs. Harlin reported that Mr. Floyd Collins was blocking the alley near his house by parking a number of cars there. A letter will be sent to Mr. Collins demanding that he clear the alley.

The need for gravel on the streets was brought up again. Mr. Proffitt will take care of this.

The clerk was directed to see if the City has an Ordinance against parking on the sidewalk.

The next meeting will be March 27, 1979. Robert Appling will chair that meeting in case of the absence of Mrs. Harlin.
