Commissioner Varner asked Mrs. Jordon if with her permission she would teach Martha Watt how to mark graves.

After last commission meeting Commissioner Varner and Martha Watt met with Mayor McCay briefly on purchase of computer system for cemetery for \$300.00. Mayor McCay said they will be updating their computer system when they move into the new building is built. The cemetery will be getting the cities old system.

Commissioner Varner asked Mrs. Jordon how much we get for opening graves. Mrs. Jordon stated that we receive \$25.00 for locating graves only.
