The regular business meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grpve, Ky. was called to order by Chairman Robert Kemble at 7:45 PM with members James Hill, Gary Vincent and Maurice Marr present. The minutes of the previous meeting and the financial standing were accepted as read. An ordinance annexing Lynmont subdivision was approved and signed by the Chairman of the board and the City Clerk. There were no reports of activity from any department heads or committees.

A delegation from the Smiths Grove Woman's Club was recognized and Mrs. Geneva Anderson acting as spokesman for the group requested the board to: (1) Issue a proclamation designating the first week in April as clean-up and paint-up week and (2) Re-sign City Streets. After discussion a motion was made by Dr. Hill and seconded by Gary Vincent the week of April 17, be designated as Clean-up, Paint-up week. This motion carried.

A motion was made by Gary Vincent and seconded by Dr. Hill that a bill for mirrors for fire truck be paid. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Dr. Hill and seconded by Gary Vincent that all fines be earmarked for special use of Police Dept. The motion carried.

As no further business was brought before the board, the meeting adjourned.
