Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Smiths Grove.

The Board met in regular session on Wednesday night, March 3, 1965 at the McGuffey Insurance Agency with one member, Trustee Joe Lowe, absent.

1. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
2. Mr. Keener had no police report. He called attention to the fact that it is his interpretation that the Judge is to be elected, not appointed. Chairman Bevarly will read the statutes concerning this requirement.
3. Hardy account is now \$530. Chairman Bevarly was of the opinion the 6 grave charge of \$210 should not be carried as an outstanding account. Chairman Bevarly advised Trustee Jordan to have Mrs. Jordan to send statements to the outstanding accounts.
4. The street arrow at Main and Kentucky has been installed and steps have been taken to correct the drainage problem at this location and at the intersection of 101 and Beller Avenue.
5. There was a general discussion regarding the fire department. Mr. Gray of the Kentucky Inspection Bureau has been in town and a letter of recommendations is expected in the near future. Steps will be taken to meet the requirements he stipulates.
- ✓ 6. Clerk has asked Mr. McGuffey to speak to Captain Sharpe regarding the locating of a State Policeman in this area. Clerk is to write a letter to Captain Shappe.
7. The lighting system was again reviewed and it was decided an additional light is needed on 101. The best location seems to be between Thomas Webb and W. L. Martin. When I-65 is completed, additional lights might be needed.
8. The Perkins Service Station debris was again discussed. Since this case is now in Court, it was decided that as soon as the case is settled, The County Attorney will be contacted regarding the proper procedure to take to force the land owner to clean-up this eye sore.
9. Stray dogs have become a menace. Chairman Beveraly is to speak to Buster Allen to see if some arrangements can be made to rid the town of strictly "strays".

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
