Smiths Grove, KY March –4 – 1944

Same Board of Trustees having been appointed met on the above date, and being duly sworn proceeded to organize. J. B. Helm, again elected Chairman, P. H. Butler, elected Clerk & Treas. F. S. Ewing, Don Hays, T.E. Madison as other members of the Board.

Motion made and sec that the regular tax for the yr - 1944 be fixed at 50 cts per \$100.00 assessed valuation of property & real estate. And that an additional levy of 20 cts per hundred dollar be made to supplement salary of marshall or policeman for the town where such one was available.

And a poll tax of \$1.50 per head on all male persons from 21 yrs of age to 70 yrs per year.

Having at this time no one acting as marshall or Police Judge motion was made to arrange with the County Judge to in some way to take care of law violators, also the water situation was discussed and a committee of two were appointed to see & consult with Adlai Kirby in regard to the sale of The waterwork to the town. F. S. Ewing & Ph. H. Butler were appointed on this committee.

No further business before the Board, same was adjourned until the next regular meeting date.
