A motion was made by Gary Vincent and seconded by Charles Whitley that a letter be written to the District Highway Engineer requesting that a speed st;dy be made to determine the feasibility of extending the 35 MPH speed limit to the City Limits. The motion carried and the clerk was instructed to comply. The next meeting date was set for June 1, 1972.

As there was no other business brought before the board, the meeting was adjourned
