Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees Tuesday night, May 2, 1967

The Board met in regular session at the American National Bank and Trust Company with one member, Trustee Joe Lowe Absent. Visitors were Jennings Garman and James Hill of the Planning and Zoning Committee.

1. The first item to be discussed was the situation at the cemetery. All agreed that Marshall Parrish needs an extra helper or a riding mower. Mr. Garman said a Gravely mower had been demonstrated and seemed a good one for this type of work. Trustee Powell made a motion that a riding mower be purchased. Trustee Powell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes. Trustees Lowe and Powell are to investigate and buy the mower.
2. There is nothing new on the water system. We have not turned on the new water waifing for Hobson Roberts to complete his hook ups.
3. Daylight saving time was discussed. All agreed to wait until after this week-end to see what Warren County does before this is decided on.
4. Clerk was asked to call Charles English regarding the amount of insurance to be carried on the water treatment plant.
5. Chairman Melton reported the deed has been made on the Spear property and the factory site needs to be annexed. A motion was made by Trustee Powell and seconded by Trustee Blackwell that the following property be annexed: From the present city limits W on the Oakland Road to the Martin-Spear line, thence south to I-65, thence east to #101, thence north to the present city limits parallel to #101. There were no dissenting votes. Chairman Melton volunteered to contact David Watkins to make this survey.
6. Dr. Hill explained the proposed ordinance which is attached to and becomes a part of these minutes. He recommended that this be adopted and the board of adjustments be appointed. Trustee Blackwell made a motion that this ordinance be adopted. Trustee Rasdall seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes. Trustee Melton asked for some time to consider the appointment of the Board of Adjustments.
7. Clerk was asked to order 12 copies of the National Building Code.

There being no further business, the Board was dismissed until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
