

**MINUTES
SMITHS GROVE CITY COMMISSION SPECIAL MEETING
MUNICIPAL ROAD AID HEARING
SMITHS GROVE MUNICIPAL BUILDING
TUESDAY, MAY 29, 2018 6:30 P.M.**

Members present: Mayor Stiffey, Commissioner Stiffey, Commissioner Vincent, Commissioner Smith and Commissioner Buehl

Mayor Stiffey called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm.


Mayor Stiffey informed all present that this was the annual Municipal Road Aid Hearing that the city is required to have every year regarding the funds the city receives and how they will be spent. He explained that these funds may only be spent to maintain the city streets.

Mayor Stiffey stated that the city expects to receive approximately thirteen thousand two hundred dollars \$13,200 this fiscal year in Road Aid funds and that we anticipate \$1100 - \$1200 funds per month. Currently the fund has \$2600 remaining after expenditures for paving.

Mayor Stiffey explained that this money comes from Kentucky Fuel Tax and that House Bill 299 determines how the funds will be calculated and distributed. Therefore, there is no way to know exactly how much we may receive.

Mayor Stiffey made the motion to accept Road Aid funds and Commissioner Vincent seconded. The motion passed with a vote of 5 – 0.

The meeting adjourned at 6:38 pm until the Regular Commission meeting at 7:00 pm.
