An Amendment to Ordinance passed at the regular meeting on April 9th. with reference to Beer liscence. to read as follows.

Beer liscence to be placed at One Hundred and Twenty Five Dollars. for any and all applicants, motion made by wiley and seconded by Long, all members present voting Aye.

An Ordinance was passed instructing the Clerk to write a letter to P A Cassady, City Marshall, to be read to the Tavern operators in the town, as follows-

On account of the numerous complaints coming to the members of the Board from the citizens of the town with reference to disordedin, and in frotyof, the Beer Taverns, particually on Saturday nights. It is important that you at once notify these beer dealers that the practice of serving the colored race in front part of their places and allow the two races to be served at the same bar, A seperate place for each race must be maintained and order must be kept in both places of serving.

It is the Boards desire to renew your liscence on the first of July and we want to cooperate with you in any way that we can but the citizens of the town, and the tax payers, must be given consideration.

This is given as a warning and if not obeyed at once and a considerable improvement shown on maintaining order, it will become necessary for the Board of Trustees to pass an Ordinance prohibiting the sale of beer after 6 P.

Their being no further buisness, the meeting was adjourned to meet Tuesday night June the 3rd.
