Motion made by O. H. Motley & 2nd by F. B. Hardy that the street committee employ some men & open sinks at W. M. Coleman's & O. H. Motley's gate.

Mrs. M. C. Walters & Mrs. Holman came before the board and asked for a street light on corner near L&N RR in front of Mrs. Walter Home. The street committee was instructed to investigate the necessity of such light.

The following claim was presented & order paid. \$133.32 for city lights to Ky. Tenn L&P. Co.

The CWA program for work in Smiths Grove was outlined by F. B. Hardy & approved by the board with a cost to the town not to exceed \$250.00.

There being no further business meeting was continued until next meeting night.
