Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees Tuesday, November 1, 1966.

The Board met at the American National Bank and Trust Company with one member, Trustee Joe Lowe, absent.

- 1. Visitors at the meeting were Graham Miller, Edwin Moss and E. W. Martin, and Jennings Garman. Chairman Melton asked them to present their problem before we proceeded with the regular meeting. Mr. Garman spoke first and said there seemed to be a drainage problem on Kentucky Street. Surface water comes from the Gym and from as far as Howard Lucas property to drain at this point. A culvert parallel to Kentucky Street has been stopped up by mud by the construction project. Mr. Garman and Mr. Moss has previously discussed the situation and each had agreed to pay $\frac{1}{4}$ on a new culvert. Mr. Graham's problem seemed to be the depth of a ditch in front of his property which is necessary for proper drainage. Trustee Rasdall suggested that this seemed to be a private matter and not Town business. Chairman Melton said a study would be made of this drainage problem. Before leaving, Mr. Garman agreed to pay 1/3 of the cost of the installation of an additional or larger culvert.
- 2. Clerk stated the insurance on the chapel should be discussed as the builder's risk needs to be cancelled because the chapel is complete. Trustee Powell made a motion that the chapel be insured for \$15,000. Trustee Blackwell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes. Clerk was asked to secure this policy on a three year cash basis.
- 3. The volunteer fire department had requested rates on additional insurance protection. Trustee Blackwell made a motion that we increase the present policy to limits of \$10,000 death, \$2500 medical and \$75 weekly benefit for life for disability. The volunteer fire department is to pay $\frac{1}{2}$ of this bill. Trustee Rasdall seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
- 4. Trustee Rasdall presented the problem of water to the Frank Russell property. He previously had water but under the present construction, his water has been cut off. It was agreed that since he is in the city limits and previously had water, then we need to furnish him with the water. Trustee Rasdall is to take care of this.
- 5. Mrs. Jordan was present and presented the cemetery report which is on file.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
