Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Wednesday, November 3, 1965.

The Board met at the McGuffey Insurance Agency with all members present.

- 1. Chairman Bevarly reported the bids for the Cemetery Chapel were all too high. The architect rechecked his figures and suggested that these beds be rejected and that we reppen. If the bids are too high the next time, then the plans will have to be revamped.
- 2. Chairman Bevarly reported that the Halloween dinner for the county police officers costs Mrs. Anderson \$30. The Board had previously voted to pay \$25 for this dinner. Trustee Jordan made a motion that we pay Mrs. Anderson the full \$30. Trustee Powell seconded the motion. There were no dissenting votes.
- 3. There has been some question as to the validity of the trust funds now on deposit. Mrs. J. B. Helm would like to see Mrs. Edward Williams Chairman of the trust fund. Her sister, rs. C. E. H. Druitt sent \$500 to be deposited in the Cemetery Trust Fund. This money is in the Woman's Club Cemetery Trust Fund. The Cemetery is the property of the City of Smiths Grove and under the direct supervision of the Town Board. No other organization has a right to collect funds or spend money for the cemetery without the consent of the Board. This question will probably be under question at future meetings.
- 4. Clerk was asked to write Mr. Whitley concerning the present status of the chapel at the Cemetery.
- 5. There being no further business the meeting adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
