

Special Meeting; Thursday, October 19, 1972. 7:30 p.m.

All Board members present as well as City Marshall William Denham.

Discussions concerned derelict automobiles parked on the city streets; Fire Department Insurance.

The subject of hiring a new City Clerk to succeed Byron Curtis was brought up. The decision was made to ask for Mr. Curtis' letter of resignation, to be effective November 1, 1972. Lucian Flora stated that his son, Stephen B. Flora, would be willing to take over the position. It was decided that a motion would be made at the next regular meeting to employ Stephen Flora in that capacity.

Additional topics brought to the members attention concerned parks in the city, the Revenue Sharing bill, and the Water Department (which included the work of Judge J.W. Blue in that sector).

City Marshall William Denham said that during Halloween the County Sheriff and the State Police had promised to help the city authorities preserve order. Marshall Denham then detailed what he intended to do during that time.
