

Special called City Commission meeting - Tuesday October 20, 1998 - 7:00 p.m.

Reconsideration bids for city sidewalk construction/reconstruction.

Mayor Gilley called the meeting to order with all commissioners in attendance.

Mayor Gilley ask the commission if they had questions regarding the bids for the city sidewalks. The Mayor explained that the commission had gone over the bids at the October 14th meeting and ask the contractors that bid to please submit some additional information for the commission's consideration. In attendance was Randy Wilson, president of Southern Kentucky Contracting, Inc. Comm. Lacy approached Mr. Wilson in regards to where he had done this type of work in the past. Mr. Wilson said he had built all of the sidewalks on Highway 68-80 from Campbell Lane to the Parkway, he had done the concrete work at the new Super Wal-Mart, and had done extensive work at the Nashville airport. He added that he had been in business since 1978 and was a licensed contractor in Tenn. as well as Kentucky. Comm. Martin said she had talked with three different contractors regarding Mr. Wilson's work and all had said he would do a good job. Mr. Wilson had submitted the additional information the city commission had requested along with his bid bond. With no further discussion to be heard, Comm. Cooke presented a motion the bid and specifications of Southern Kentucky Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$155,935 for the construction/reconstruction of the city sidewalks be accepted, seconded by Comm. Hardy. roll call and vote - Cooke yes, Gilley yes, Martin yes, Hardy yes, Lacy yes.

With no further business to be discussed a motion to adjourn was heard.
