sick, also approved.

H. Bishop was to be retained as a  
deputy marshall at present rate of  
salary \$25.00 per month for the  
time being, to be later determined  
by the board.

Streets as heretofore planned, were  
ordered to be built on arrival  
of State Highway department in  
said town.

J. E. Bohanon was empowered  
with authority to receive bids on  
priming oil + other oil necessary  
for the construction of  
College St. Broadway, Highland,  
Roosevelt Ave, Stock St. First,  
Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth,  
+ Mill Sts totaling 10265 ft in  
said town, and to purchase  
same from the best bidder or

bidders,

It was also ordered to borrow an amount of money necessary to construct said streets above the amount of cash on hand when said streets were completed.

There being no further business, meeting was adjourned on vote of Council until next regular meeting time.
