Minutes of the meeting of the Board of Trustees, Wednesday, October 5, 1955.

Due to Chairman Melton being unable to attend on Tuesday, October 4, 1955, the meeting was postponed to Wednesday, October 5, 1955, at 7:30 PM, in the Director's Room of the Deposit Bank and the following business transacted:

- 1. The meeting opened with a discussion of the City's financial condition. According to the estimates it is figured that we will be able to pay for all the paving of Broadway and Church Street (from Mr. Meredith's corner to colored Church) and about 120 feet of Cave Street and have a bit of money left for operating expenses.
 - 2. Mrs. Stone presented a proposal by the Homemaker's and Woman's Clubs that they plant flower beds in the triangles at the Cemetery. The Bordrd, after a look at the plat of the Cemetery in the Bank Lobby, upon a motion of Mrs. Stone, seconded Mr. Tarter, agreed to give those two clubs permission to plant said flower beds.
- 3. Mr. Meredith was present and presented data on street markers, etc. He reported that they had received 36 markers which had been distributed over town in the approximate location of where they will be set. He stated that each marker was located on S.W. corner of each block. He further stated that he believed they should be set in concrete and that he felt the City should pay installation costs. Mr. Tarter was designated to represent City in installing markers and Mr. Meredith agreed to assist him in installation of same. Mr. Tarter is authorized to hire whatever labor is necessary and to procure whatever material is necessary. Mr. Meredith agreed to see about paint, etc., for marking them.
- 3. Mr. Meredith further presented the proposed house numbering system. He presented the attached alphabetical list of names and proposed number for each resident or owner, along with a map of the City which had the approximate location of all streets and all buildings with number for each. He stated that since the Lion's Club had no legal authority that Board pass this system, assigning numbers as listed. Chairman Melton stated that Board could pass the Ordinance assigning numbers and through publicity, tell people what they could do as regards the numbers. Mr. Meredith stated that he would cut a stencil and mimeograph letter to each person assigning their number.

Upon a motion of Mrs. Crump, seconded Mrs. Stone, the City hereby adopts this system of numbering the places. All citizens will be advised that they have been assigned certain numbers and request they secure house number. Copy of numbering system attached hereto. There were no dissenting votes.

Chairman Melton suggested that notice of same be put in Park City Daily News so that people will become better acquainted with the system.

4. Mr. Meredith mentioned that it had been proposed that Lion's Club procure trash bins to place on Main Street through the business area. The Board stated that they would make arrangements to have bins emptied at certain times if bins are procured.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time the meeting was adjourned until its next regularly scheduled meeting Tuesday, November 1, 1955.
