10. Clerk was asked to write Mammoth Cave Telephone Company, David Perkins, Ford Thomas, L & N, F. E. Moss, Leonard Whittle, L. D. Rasdall, W. C. Hawkins, and Bob Weisenberger concerning the growth of weeds on lots.

Th. George Anderson attadded the meeting with a complaint that the hedge by Mrs. Rose Shank's was causing a blind corner. Mr. Cassady said Mrs. Shank had been contacted and had promised to cut the hedge.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned until the next regularly scheduled meeting the second Tuesday in November.
