The Board of Trustees convened in the Director's Room of the Deposit Bank at 7:30 P.M., Tuesday, October 7, 1952, all members Mr . Melton, Chairman, Mr. Barlow, Mrs. Stone, Mrs. Crump, and Mr. Madison being present, and the following business was transacted:

Report on Fire Truck - Fr Truck has been completely overhauled. Cost of repairs to truck by Priddy's Garage \$208.00. Repairs to pumper by Hanley Machine Co. \$108.00. Stripping truck by Duke Thomas $\$ 9.00$.

Sidewalk and curb from Main Street to Fire Station - Mr. Madison and Chairman Melton to confer with Dan Mar as to specifications, etc.

Installation of heater at Fire Station - Bids have been made by J. A. Malone for $\$ 115.00$ and Lee Electric for $\$ 115.00$. Mrs. Stone is to call Western Ky. Gas Co. for a bid.

Mr. Barlow is to check on how much it would cost to paint Fire Stetion and ask for bids.

Ordinance - Motion made by Mrs. Stone, seconded Mrs. Crump that fine of $\$ 5.00$ plus costs be assessed for burning anything on llain Street pavement. Marshal shall see that law is strictly enforced". Clerk to notify all residents and business men on Main Street of said ordinance.

Ordinance - Motion made by Mrs. Stone, seconded Mrs. Crump, that Marshal get fine wire to put over window and door of jail to prevent outsiders slipping beer or anything else to prisoners.

Clerk to get Buster Allen or someone else to clean jail whenever needed at $50 \nless$ per hour.

Clerk to pay Judge Lowe $\$ 24.50$ for blankets and cot for jail.

Clerk to pay Judge $\$ 24.00$ and Marshall $\$ 36.00$ as commission on fines in past 30 days.

Clerk to notify Pine Theater that their Occupation tax is $\$ 20.00$ per year. Collect for only $\$ 9$ months or $3 / 4$ th of total.

Clerk to notify Mrs. Elkin that it is alright for her to take only 2 cemetary lots,.
