The following resolution was presented to the board of trustees: Be it resolved that a license tax of \$50 per year be imposed upon all peddlers and itinerant retailers of goods for the sale and delivery of their goods and merchandise in the town of Smiths Grove, Warren County, Kentucky, the proceeds of which are to be used to help defer the cost of police protection within the town limits, and that the sale of any goods and/or merchandise without a license by any such peddler or itinerant retailer of goods shall constitute an offense against the peace and dignity of the town of Smiths Grove and for each day that said peddler or ininerant retailer of goods violates this ordinance that he, she, or it shall be subject to a fine of \$5.00 for each day and that effective date of this ordinance be as of the first day of September, 1958. Clerk of the town board be hereby directed to make public the contents of this ordinance by posting typewritten copies of this ordinance in at least 10 conspicuous places in the town of Smiths Grove, Warren County, Kentucky, Whereupon Trustee Bethel Denton moved the adoption of the foregoing resolution and Trustee Carrie Lee Jordan seconded the motion. After a discussion of the resolution same was placed before the Trustees for a vote, whereupon Geneva Anderson voted yes and Leon Tarter voted yes. Thereupon the chairman of the board declared that said ordinance had been adopted.
