The following resolution was presented to the board of trustees: Be it resolved that a license tax of \$10.00 per year be imposed upon all persons or firms or corporations for the privilege of soliciting orders for books or other printing matter, cosmetics, brushes, and any other merchandse or services, said merchandise or services to be performed at a later date in the town of Smiths Grove, Warren County, Kentucky, the procees of which are to be used to defer the cost of police protection within the town limits, and that the solicitation of any such orders for merchandise of other services without a license by any such solicitor shall constitute an offense against the peace and dignity of the town of Smiths Grove and for each day that said ordinance be violated the offender shall be subject to a fine of \$10.00 and that effective date of this ordinance shall be as of the first day of September, 1958, and that the town clerk be hereby directed to make public this ordinance by posting in ten conspicuous places in the town of Smiths Grove, Warren County, Kentucky, typewritten copies of this ordinance. Whereupon Trustee Bethel Denton moved the adoption of the foregoing resolution and Trustee Carrie Lee Jordan seconded the motion. After a discussion of the resolution same was placed before the Trustees for a vote, whereupon Geneva Anderson voted yes and Leon Tarter voted yes. Thereupon the chairman of the board declared that said ordinance had been adopted.
