

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-001

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING AN ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE SMITHS GROVE
MAYOR AND SMITHS GROVE CITY COMMISSIONERS**

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statutes 83A-070 allows the legislative body of each city to fix compensation of every elected city officer by ordinance as long as the Ordinance is passed no later than the first Monday in May in the year the officer is elected. An elected officer's compensation shall not be changed after his election or during his term of office; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Smiths Grove recognizes the necessity of paying a salary for the time and effort spent by the Mayor, and

WHEREAS, the City of Smiths Grove recognizes that through a small salary it has the possibility of retaining good Commission members and attracting good Commission members in the future and can give a better quality of government to all citizens:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SMITHS GROVE,
KENTUCKY, THAT:**

The City of Smiths Grove hereby sets an Annual Salary of \$7,200.00 (\$600 per month) for the Mayor, beginning with the January 2023 meeting and an Annual Salary of \$2,400 (\$200 per month) for the City Commissioners, beginning with the January 2023 meeting.

The passage of this Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to the Ordinance 2018-001 revising the "\$2,400.00 for the Mayor beginning with the January 2019 meeting" and repeals Ordinance 13-01, Section 4, pertaining to \$1,200.00 for each City Commissioner and the \$1,600.00 for the Mayor which began with the January 2015 meeting.

That this Ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.

Passed by First Reading by roll call vote, 5-0 on 28th day of February, 2022.

Passed roll call vote, 4-0 and adopted on the Second Reading, 28th of March, 2022.
