

P.A.C.E. Marathon 2024

Featuring: Ed Spear Park, Oakland, Smiths Grove Cemetery, and Smiths Grove

- ❖ When:
 - May 11, 2024
 - Registration will be completed on RecDesk, or in person on 5/10 at the packet pickup night, which will be held at the Smiths Grove Library Branch.
- ❖ Where:
 - The Marathon all will begin and end at Ed Spear Park
 - Marathon starting at 7:00a
- ❖ Routes:
 - See attached handouts.
- ❖ Logistics
 - Mile sponsors:
 - There will be mile sponsors (1-25). These mile sponsors will be responsible for any water/snack stations within that mile. They can also be the hype for that mile. They are also responsible for cleaning up that mile to make sure we leave every road as good or better than we found it.
 - These sponsors will be local businesses/organizations to Warren County and by sponsoring a mile they will be featured in the race packet the runners pick up the evening before, on the back of the shirts, as well as on flyers/banners.
 - Price for participants:
 - The below pricing will go towards paying for their shirt/medal as well as to assist in paying for banners and other promotional items.
 - 5K- \$25
 - Half- \$50
 - Marathon- \$75
 - Each runner will receive a shirt (5k, Half, and Marathon)
 - Each finisher of the Half and Marathon will receive a medal that will be unique to this race.
 - There will also be a Premiere Medal for the top 3 finishers in each age group.
 - Ed Spear
 - Due to Ed Spear being the starting and ending point for the race, we will have a DJ set up, and snacks for the runners.
- We have a dedicated ambulance that will be stationed at Ed Spear for the event.
- We would reach out to Caveland Environmental and ask for 16 portable toilets to be placed along the route. Minimum of 2 being ADA-compliant.

- Packet Pickup Friday Night
 - The night before the race will be when the runners pick up their “packets”. These packets will include their shirt, race number, and any promotional items from any/all mile sponsors. The pickups will be at the Smiths Grove Library Branch. If approved, there will be food trucks, live music, rec games, etc. to welcome people to our park and the community. We were thinking of also marketing this as a Smiths Grove Block Party so the community can be involved in all the fun this night has to offer.
